








Jeollanamdo education will help children grow into holistic individuals.

Advancement of Responsible Education for Basic Academic Skills

- + Placement of teachers exclusively responsible for ensuring the acquisition of basic academic skills in elementary schools

 first in Korea
- + Implementing a supplemental remedial learning program (elementary: learning lead-up, middle: learning ability 3Up, high: academic skills level-up)
- + Operation of Al Tutor and Edu-Tech Mentoring






Establishment of Free Education and Free School Meals

- + School uniform subsidy for first year middle and high school students
- + Free high school education
- + Free school meals at all schools
- * Free Education (tuition fees, school operation support fees, textbook fees)






Establishing Foundation for High School Credit System

- + Successful expansion of high school credit system to research schools and increasing the number of leading schools to 50
- + Expansion of online/offline joint curriculum courses
- + Operation of an online training center for joint curriculum (9 subjects, including AI math)






Expansion of Program Support for Customized Career Paths and Higher Learning

[Number of companies recognized as leading companies]




The future is a place where our confident students can live.

- + Supporting former integrated schools (reorganization, etc.)








[Budget for 5-year plan of Green Smart Future Schools]

[Number of teachers who get trained for the online class platform]






Students, teachers, parents, and local residents create the foundation of our schools.

- + Jeollanamdo Student Council: 141 students in 2nd grade of high school











- + 10 villages for Study in Jeollanamdo






Professional Development for Faculty Members

- + Set caps on project financing


